

WPR/RC37.R4 REPORT OF THE SUB-COMMITTEE ON PROGRAMMES AND TECHNICAL
COOPERATION: MANAGERIAL PROCESS FOR NATIONAL HEALTH
DEVELOPMENT, INCLUDING HEALTH MANPOWER DEVELOPMENT ASPECTS

The Regional Committee,

Having considered Part I of the report of the Sub-Committee on Programmes and Technical Cooperation on its visits to Malaysia and Papua New Guinea,¹

1. ENDORSES the findings and recommendations of the Sub-Committee on Programmes and Technical Cooperation in relation to WHO's cooperation in the managerial process for national health development, including health manpower development aspects;
2. THANKS the Sub-Committee for its work;

3. REQUESTS the Regional Director to take the Sub-Committee's findings and recommendations into consideration in developing future programmes of cooperation, particularly with respect to:

(1) the strengthening of formal training programmes;

(2) continuing education programmes for health workers;

(3) the upgrading of planning and management skills of key staff at the intermediate level; and

(4) the promotion of technical cooperation among countries, particularly in formulating solutions to training problems and primary health care development issues;

4. REQUESTS the Sub-Committee, as part of its terms of reference in 1987, to review and analyse the impact of WHO's cooperation with Member States in the field of tuberculosis and malaria control.
