9.1 Programme budget 1998–1999: budget performance (interim report)

Information is also provided on funding from extrabudgetary sources.

This annual progress report details the current status of the campaign to eradicate poliomyelitis in the Region. It also reports on progress made with regard to the certification of the eradication of poliomyelitis.

WPR/RC50/7

This annual report describes the situation of sexually transmitted infections, HIV infections and AIDS, as requested by resolution WPR/RC49.R3. An update on use of antiretroviral agents in the treatment of HIV/AIDS is also provided.

12. Tuberculosis prevention and control

WPR/RC50/8 Rev.1

This report is a response to concerns about tuberculosis expressed at the forty-ninth session of the Regional Committee. The epidemiological situation and the regional strategy for tuberculosis control are described. Urgent action is needed, in both developing and developed countries, to reduce the Region's tuberculosis burden.

13. Hepatitis and related diseases

The report describes progress in control of viral hepatitis in the Region. Among other issues, the report discusses immunization against hepatitis B, blood safety, hepatitis B and C transmission among drug users and clinical treatment.
