TECHNICAL DISCUSSIONS ON MATTERS OF REGIONAL INTEREST

The Executive Board at its Eighth Session invited Regional Committees to consider the advisability of holding technical discussions on matters of regional interest in connection with sessions of the Regional Committee. This recommendation is based upon the success of such technical discussions held in connection with the Fourth World Health Assembly and the plans for their continuation in future assemblies.

The Regional Committee may wish to consider this recommendation and, if appropriate, decide upon a topic. In view of the success of the discussions at the Fourth World Health Assembly on the subject: "The Education and Training of Medical and Public Health Personnel", and in view of the prime importance of this subject in this Region, the Regional Committee may wish to discuss its regional aspects.

Should the Regional Committee decide to hold discussions on the above or any other subject, it may wish to approve a resolution along the following lines:

The Regional Committee:

DECIDES to hold technical discussions in connection with its next Session on the subject:

REQUESTS the Regional Director, in consultation with governments, to prepare an agenda and collect preparatory data and information;

URGES Member Governments to include in their delegations technical personnel in the subject to be discussed.
