GENERAL PROGRAMME OF WORK FOR A SPECIFIC PERIOD  
(AGENDA NO. 13.1)

The Fifth World Health Assembly in its eighth plenary meeting passed a resolution (A5/R/25) requesting the Director-General to recommend to Regional Committees that their annual programmes be so planned as to secure adequate integration of such programmes in the approved general programme of the Organization.

The Regional Committee at its present session may wish to pass a resolution along the following lines :

The Regional Committee for the Western Pacific:

NOTES Resolution A5/R/25 of the Fifth World Health Assembly covering the general programme of work for a specific period;

RECOMMENDS that Member Countries of the Region see to it that their annual programmes be so planned as to secure adequate integration of such programmes in the approved general programme of the Organization; and

RE-ITERATES the previous recommendation contained in its Resolution WP/RC2/R7 that Member Countries of the Region make full use of the consulting service available from the Regional Office and keep the Regional Office informed of their desire for assistance of this type.
