TIME AND PLACE OF ELEVENTH SESSION
OF THE REGIONAL COMMITTEE FOR THE WESTERN PACIFIC

The Director-General has had a preliminary study made on the timing of the Fourteenth World Health Assembly should the Thirteenth World Health Assembly decide to accept the invitation of the Government of India to the Health Assembly to meet in New Delhi in 1961.

Because of the climatic conditions prevailing in New Delhi, the Director-General intends to suggest that the Assembly should meet in February 1961. If this recommendation is accepted, the schedule of meetings of the Executive Board and its Standing Committee on Administration and Finance prior to the Fourteenth World Health Assembly would have to be revised as follows:

Standing Committee on Administration
and Finance 25 October 1960

Executive Board 2 November 1960

In order that the proposed programme and budget estimates may be submitted in accordance with the Rules of Procedure of the Executive Board and the World Health Assembly, and with the Financial Regulations, it will be necessary for the Regional Committee to have completed its work in 1960 no later than the middle of August.

In view of the possible changes in the time-table which will be necessary should the Thirteenth World Health Assembly and the twenty-sixth session of the Executive Board decide that the Fourteenth World Health Assembly should meet in New Delhi, it is suggested that the Regional Committee does not decide on a definite date for its session in 1960 but should leave the matter to the discretion of the Regional Director.

In accordance with the principle of rotation the eleventh session of the Regional Committee should be held in Manila.
