

ORGANIZATIONAL STUDY ON "CO-ORDINATION AT THE NATIONAL LEVEL IN RELATION TO THE TECHNICAL CO-OPERATION FIELD PROGRAMME OF THE ORGANIZATION"

The Regional Committee,

Having considered resolution WHA20.48 adopted by the Twentieth World Health Assembly on co-ordination at the national level in relation to the technical co-operation field programme of the Organization,

1. ENDORSES the opinion of the Health Assembly that it is primarily the responsibility of governments to co-ordinate their own health programmes and also the aid they receive from external assistance;
2. EMPHASIZES the usefulness of national co-ordination committees;
3. RECOMMENDS that whenever it is considered appropriate, governments call upon the services of the WHO representatives to facilitate their task of co-ordinating health activities receiving technical assistance.
