Page 104. Paragraph 2. Delete the first sentence. The paragraph should read:

As with other developing countries, the major causes of death are predominantly those related to modern lifestyle, a marked shift from those caused by infectious diseases about three decades ago. Heart diseases (including acute rheumatic fever), malignant neoplasms, diabetes, cerebrovascular diseases as well as bronchitis, chronic and unspecified emphysema and asthma accounted for about 50% of deaths in 2001.

Page 205. Paragraph 5. Delete "malaria" from the first sentence. The paragraph should read:

Several communicable diseases remain public health priorities, such as TB, dengue fever, HIV/AIDS, and hepatitis B. In addition to surveillance of communicable diseases, national control programmes for diseases such as TB and HIV/AIDS are in place.
